



# Kukui'ula Outrigger Canoe Club

## READ CAREFULLY

### **This is a waiver and release of liability**

I realize that danger exists in my participation in Kukuiula Outrigger's paddling activities.

Although I am in good health and I am a strong swimmer and able to participate in such activities, I realize that such participation may result in illness or injury due to accidents, the forces of nature, or other causes not foreseeable. Such illness and injury may include disease, strains, sprains, fractures, dislocations, paralysis, drowning and/or death. Possible injuries may cause serious and permanent disability. By my participation in this activity, I hereby knowingly assume the risks arising out of this activity.

I also, on behalf of myself, my personal representatives and my heirs, hereby agree to release, hold harmless and indemnify KUKUIULA OUTRIGGER and its agents, officers and employees from any and all claims and suits for bodily injury, property damage, wrongful death, loss of services or otherwise which may arise out of my participation in KUKUIULA OUTRIGGER's activities, whether or not such claims or suits arise from negligent acts by the organizers and conductors of this activity, their employees or volunteers, another participant, or any other person and/or from any other cause.

I agree to be liable for any damage which I may cause to the CLUB property including canoes, paddles, etc., and the amount of the same shall be billed to me by the CLUB.

- Recruiting**—Recruits new members. Distributes recruiting flyers and other publications. Provides notice to media, etc.
- Fundraising**—Help plan and organize all fund-raising activities of the club (*Mike Balik Memorial Canoe Race and Koloa Plantation Days Family Fun Run*).
- Buildings and Grounds**—Assist in maintenance of the club premises and facilities.
- Canoes and Equipment**—Assist in the repair and maintenance of canoes and equipment.
- Education**—Assist in the continuing program of instruction in the Hawaiian culture and outrigger canoe paddling. It is the goal of this committee to provide instruction in a variety of topics including but not limited to:
  - Navigation, wind, currents, and swells
  - Voyaging and open water paddling
  - Canoe Rigging and Canoe Terminology
  - Hawaiian history and language
- Historian/Publicity/Website Manager**—Assist in keeping records of club events, races and placing by crews. Taking photos posting on website and/or club Facebook page or other online venues and submitting pictures and articles to newspaper as needed.
- Safety**—Assist in developing a continuing program of instruction in safety awareness and emergency procedures.
- Transportation and Logistics**—Assist in coordinating movement of canoes and equipment.
